

## Plan Management Facts

Plan Managers assist you to manage the funds in your NDIS plan. Plan Management is different from having the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) manage the funding in your plan or if you self-manage your plan.

It is worth using a Plan Manager because they can:

- Help you to improve your knowledge about managing the funds in your plan
- Pay providers for you
- Increase the choice of providers you have
- Send you reports so that you can control your budget

The cost of having Plan Management is paid for by the NDIA and you can get a Plan Manager by asking your Local Area Coordinator or NDIS Planner.

Choosing to have a Plan Manager means that you can use registered and unregistered providers which gives you more choice and control over who you use.
